## Criminal Justice Reform Indiana Statewide Survey

N=600 Likely Voters // July 18-20, 2018

## SUMMARY OF KEY FINDINGS

- 1. In your opinion, how important is it to reduce the number of people who are in prison in America today?
  - 68% TOTALIMPORTANT
  - 26% TOTAL NOT IMPORTANT
  - 36% Very important
  - 32% Somewhat important
  - 14% Not very important
  - 12% Not at all important
  - 6% Don't Know/Refused
- 2. Thinking ahead to the midter melections this November how important to you is the issue of criminal justice reform as you decide who you'll be voting for?
  - 79% TOTALIMPORTANT
  - 18% TOTAL NOT IMPORTANT
  - 43% Very important
  - 36% Somewhat important
  - 12% Not very important
  - 6% Not at all important
  - 3% Don't know



3. As you may know, the US House of Representatives recently passed the FIRST STEP Act by a large bipartisan majority. The FIRST STEP Act is a criminal justice reform bill that helps federal inmates transition to life after prison and allows for reduced prison time for well-behaved and older inmates.

In your opinion, how important is it that the US Senate – which is controlled by a Republican majority – pass the FIRST STEP Act before the November midterm elections?

- 69% TOTALIMPORTANT
- 26% TOTAL NOT IMPORTANT
- 28% Very important
- 41% Somewhat important
- 16% Notvery important
- 10% Not at all important
- 5% Don't Know/Refused
